

AGREEMENT OF COOPERATION

between

FACULTY OF DENTISTRY, ARISTOTLE UNIVERSITY OF THESSALONIKI
REPUBLIC OF GREECE

and

GRADUATE SCHOOL OF NATURAL SCIENCES AND TECHNOLOGY,
OKAYAMA UNIVERSITY
JAPAN

Faculty of Dentistry, Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, Republic of Greece and Graduate School of Natural Sciences and Technology, Okayama University, Japan, in recognition of their common interests in developing bilateral relations, are convinced that cooperation between the two institutions contributes to cultural enrichment, scientific progress, and the consolidation of friendship between the two countries. Thus, the both parties hereby agree to establish the following Agreement of Cooperation.

I

This Agreement of Cooperation will promote activities in the following principal areas:

- 1) To organize and conduct joint research projects, seminars and symposiums,
- 2) To exchange faculty, staff and students,
- 3) To exchange research experience, annual reports, and other publications,
- 4) To conduct other activities which both parties agree to.

II

Specific mechanisms for the implementation of the cooperative and collaborative activities named above shall be established and described in corresponding Appendices to this Agreement.

III

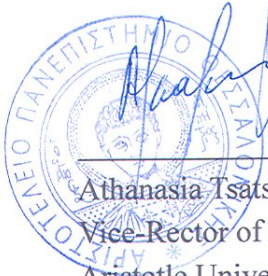
All activities developed under the auspices of this Agreement will respect and conform to the corresponding norms, traditions and regulations of each University.


IV

1. This Agreement is established for a period of five years, effective from the date of signing.
2. This Agreement can be modified by means of mutually agreed additional written clauses.
3. At the end of each five-year period, the present Agreement will be renewed automatically for another five years, unless either institution provides written notification of a decision of non-renewal six months prior to the expiration date.




