**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING  
BETWEEN  
RYERSON UNIVERSITY  
AND  
ARISTOTLE UNIVERSITY OF THESSALONIKI**

**Ryerson University and Aristotle University of Thessaloniki** having decided to enter into a collaborative relationship to promote educational, research and cultural programs in keeping with the mandates of both parties, here agree as follows:

1. The two Universities shall promote opportunities for collaboration that may include, but not limited to the following Schools of:

Psychology  
Mathematics  
Biology  
Informatics  
Political Sciences  
Mechanical Engineering  
Electrical and Computer Engineering  
Early Childhood Education  
Journalism and Mass Media

2. Any activity carried out within the board framework of this Memorandum shall be subject to the mutual consent of both institutions taking into account constraints of time, funding and other relevant resources.
3. Each activity will be governed by terms and conditions to be separately negotiated and mutually agreed by both institutions through an exchange of letters or the signing of a separate joint agreement.
4. This Memorandum of Understanding shall be effective for five (5) years and it will be reviewed and renewed for successive additional periods of five (5) years by mutual agreement.
5. This Memorandum of Understanding may be terminated at any time by either party providing six (6) months written notice to the other party of its intention to do so.

This Memorandum of Understanding shall take effect when it is signed by both parties.


