

RENEWAL

of the agreement for academic co-operation between the ARISTOTLE UNIVERSITY OF THESSALONIKI and the UNIVERSITY OF ARTS IN BELGRADE

The contracting parties 1) Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, represented by its Vice-Rector for Academic Affairs Professor EKATERINI DOUKA-KABITOGLOU and 2) University of Arts in Belgrade, represented by its Rector Professor CEDOMIR VASIC, agreed on the following:

This agreement of academic cooperation, first signed in 1997 between the two Universities, is now renewed for another three-year period. The contract is in force immediately after the authorized representatives of both Universities have signed it.

Both contracting parties agree to exchange:

- 1. Two (2) students annually for a three-month period each, to attend laboratory courses
- 2. Ten (10) students annually for ten (10) days, to participate in activities such as exhibitions and field trips. The exchange students shall bear all costs associated with their exchange; however both Universities will assist students in finding low-cost accommodation. To realize that from the part of Aristotle University, the exchange visit for the students of the University of Arts/Belgrade should take place during the period between 15th till 30th September of each year.
- 3. Furthermore, the Aristotle University will offer each year scholarships to two (2) students from the University of Arts in Belgrade to attend the intensive summer School of Modern Greek Language (August 16th September15th). The University of Arts will also offer two (2) scholarships for students from Aristotle University to attend Summer Art School of the University of Arts. This renewal pertains to all the conditions of the original agreement.

In confirmation of this agreement this document is prepared in two (2) exact copies in English and is signed by the contracting parties.
