## RENEWAL of the LETTER OF INTENT ON CONTINUING THE COURSE OF POLISH LANGUAGE AT THE ARISTOTLE UNIVERSITY OF THESSALONIKI

The present Letter of Intent wishes to renew the will expressed in the Letter of Intent signed on November 8th, 2019 and is made by and between the three Parties:

- 1. The Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, with its seat in University Campus, 54 124 Thessaloniki, Greece, represented in this act by the H.M. Rector of the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, Professor Nikolaos G. Papaioannou,
- 2. The Adam Mickiewicz University in Poznan, with its main seat in 1, Wieniawskiego Str., 61 712 Poznan, Poland, represented in this act by the H.M. Rector of the Adam Mickiewicz University in Poznan, Professor Bogumila Kaniewska,
- 3. The Embassy of the Republic of Poland in Athens, with its seat in 22, Chryssanthemon Str., 154 52 Paleo Psychiko, Athens, Greece, represented in this act by H.E. Artur Lompart.

In accordance with Article 11 of the Agreement between the Government of the Republic of Poland and the Government of the Hellenic Republic on cooperation in the fields of culture, education, science, sport, youth and mass media signed in Warsaw on 8 July 2013 the Parties agree to continue the Course of Polish language in the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki.

The Course will be supported by the Adam Mickiewicz University in Poznan and the Polish Authorities represented by the Embassy of the Republic of Poland in Athens. For this purpose, the Adam Mickiewicz University in Poznan, after approval by the competent Polish Authorities, will finance the fee for the Polish language lector and will provide Polish language textbooks for students attending the above-mentioned Course.

The Language Course will be located in Aristotle University of Thessaloniki Campus, and will start to run from October 2021, for two (2) semesters, for three (3) groups of students, three (3) academic hours per week for each group. The language level of the course will be A1 (beginners) and A2.

The Aristotle University of Thessaloniki will host the Course and provide lecture halls for the classes.

The Language Course program will be prepared by the lector of the Polish language, who will be selected by the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki from the candidates proposed by the Embassy of the Republic of Poland in Athens and Adam Mickiewicz University in Poznan.

The parties of the Letter of Intent will undertake actions towards developing cooperation between the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki and the Adam Mickiewicz University in Poznań based on the programs of the Polish National Agency for Academic Exchange.

This Letter of Intent represents the will of the Parties and does not create any legal obligations for the Parties.
