AGREEMENT BETWEEN DEPARTMENTS OF INTERNATIONAL STUDIES

Annex: Department of International Studies

*Section 1:*

1. Students applying for scholarships, fellowships and graduate assistantships will be evaluated according to the procedures established by each institution for all applicants.

*Section 2:*

1. For junior faculty who wish to pursue advanced degrees at Kent State University, the procedures for admission and graduate appointment defined in *Section 1* apply.

2. Junior faculty who wish to do research at Kent State University and present the results for the appropriate degree at Aristotle University, will be (upon approval by the Department) designated as "Scholars in Residence" or "Visiting Scientist". As "Scholars in Residence" or "Visiting Scientist" they will be provided offices, faculty library privileges and laboratory space (as available). Informal attendance at classes will be possible.

3. All faculty of Aristotle University, Department of International Studies, who wish to use the facilities of Kent State University for research, upon approval by the Department will be designated as "Scholars in Residence" or "Visiting Scientist" and appropriate facilities, as available, will be provided.

4. If required, appropriate documentation of a Scholar's residence will be provided.

5. The principles and conditions defined in this *Section* also apply to Kent State faculty and students who wish to undertake advanced work or research at Aristotle University.

Section 3:

1. The Departments of International Studies will exchange dossiers of faculty members interested in teaching classes in the representative departments, or in other ways participating in the exchange.

2. Selection of faculty involved in exchange will be made by the appropriate authority in each department, according to the procedures established, or to be established by the respective departments, subject to approval (at Kent State University) by the Director of the Center for International and Comparative Programs, upon advice by the Executive Committee of the CICP, and appropriate administrative officers of each institution.

3. Exchanges may be for a full academic year, for one term, for a summer session, or for a specified series of lectures or a period of research.

4. Exchanges need not always be reciprocal.
