AGREEMENT OF COOPERATION

between the

ARISTOTLE UNIVERSITY OF THESSALONIKI -SCHOOL OF VETERINARY MEDICINE-

and the

UNIVERSITY OF VETERINARY MEDICINE HANNOVER, FOUNDATION

Aristotle University of Thessaloniki – School of Veterinary Medicine - and University of Veterinary Medicine Hannover, Foundation, wishing to enhance relations between the two universities and to develop academic and culture interchange in the areas of education, research, and other activities, agree to cooperate and work together toward the internationalization of higher education.

The areas of cooperation will include any program offered at either university which is determined to be desirable and feasible for the achievement of these objectives. However, any specific program will be subject to the availability of funds and the mutual agreement of the universities. Such programs may include:

- a. Exchange of faculty members
- b. Exchange of students
- c. Exchange of scientific materials, publications and information
- d. Joint research projects
- e. Joint conferences
- f. Joint cultural programs
- g. Other activities as agreed upon by both parties.

The terms of such mutual assistance and cooperation shall be discussed and agreed upon in writing by the appropriate responsible offices of both parties prior to the implementation of any particular program or activity.

This agreement of cooperation will become effective upon signature and will be valid for five years. The agreement is to be reviewed within one year prior to the termination. It may be extended or amended by mutual written agreement of both institutions.
