AGREEMENT FOR ACADEMIC COOPERATION
between
Aristotle University of Thessaloniki
and
Charles University

Preamble

The Aristotle University of Thessaloniki (University Campus 54124 Thessaloniki Greece),
hereafter called 'AUTH', represented by its Rector, Prof. Pericles A. Mitkas

and

Charles University (Ovocny trh 560/5, 116 36 Prague 1, Czech Republic,
VAT No. : CZ00216208, ID No. : 00216208), hereafter called 'CU', represented by its Rector,
Prof. Tomáš Zima, MD., DSc.

recognizing the value of educational, cultural and scientific exchange and collaboration between the two universities, have decided to add the present Appendix to the existing Agreement for Academic Cooperation in order to plan a number of joint actions with regards to academic cooperation. The two components of the present Appendix are hereinafter referred to as the "parties".

I.

The purpose of this Appendix is to facilitate and to enhance the academic cooperation between the Department of History and Archaeology and the Chair of Jewish Studies, School of Philosophy, Aristotle University of Thessaloniki and the Faculty of Social Sciences, Charles University in

planning and creating a Summer School regarding the following academic issues: "Nationalism, Religion and Violence in Europe and the Mediterranean".

II.

The development and implementation of the Summer School shall be organized and provided in the summer of 2017 on the premises of the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki and in the summer of 2018 on the premises of the Charles University.

III.

Other institutions, such as universities and NGOs with interest and expertise on the academic topics of the Summer School, may join in as special academic partners under special terms. The necessary agreements and arrangements will be the task of the host faculty.

IV.

The parties shall cooperate closely in order to organize the Summer School. The two universities will nominate and authorize one representative each, Professor Basil C. Gounaris (AUTH) and Assistant Professor PhDr. Kateřina Králová, PhD (CU) to undertake the preparation and coordination of all the clauses covered by this Appendix.

V.

If and insofar there are sufficient funds for the specific purposes at the disposal of the partners, the travel expenses of the teaching staff shall be covered either by the host or by the sending partner faculty. Otherwise the teaching staff shall cover travel and accommodation expenses at their own expense. The compensation of the teaching staff will be at the discretion of the host partner.

VI.

The compensation of the representative and the administrative staff of each partner will be at its discretion.

VII.

The host faculty will be responsible for selecting the students, collecting tuition fees and ensuring that the students are oriented, have medical insurance and understand the expectations both parties have for the participants in the program.

VIII.

The partner faculty shall undertake every effort to raise funds from outside sources, for the exchange of lecturers and/or researchers and for providing as many scholarships as possible.

IX.

Both parties agree that in the case of insufficient participation of students, the Summer School shall not be organized. In such case, no party shall be responsible towards the other party for any financial or other loss or damages and each of them shall bear its own costs.

X.

This Appendix to the Agreement for Academic Cooperation becomes valid when signed by the legal representatives of both parties. It is entered into for a period of two (2) years. After this period, an evaluation of the results achieved shall take place. A renewal or extension of the Appendix shall depend on the outcome of this evaluation and must be agreed upon by both sides. It is drawn up in 2 originals in English. Each party will receive one copy.

XI.

The contracting parties agree that proposed changes to the Appendix' contents or validity are to be communicated in writing to the partner university and agreed upon by both parties. Any early termination of the Appendix requires a notification in writing and will only become effective with the termination of the work schedule then in existence.

XII.

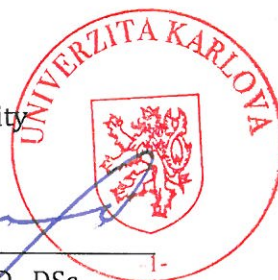
All aspects or organization, ethics and financial administration will be regulated according to the rules of the host institution.
