REGARDING STUDENTS EXCHANGE



Having regard to the Co-operation Framework Agreements signed on 17th of May 2012 between University of Basilicata and Technological Educational Institute of Crete and on 28th of September 2012 between University of Basilicata and Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, in order to give the opportunity to their students to broaden the scope of their academic curriculum through a unique learning experience abroad, apart from Socrates/Erasmus Programme, the parties agree as follows:

DEFINITIONS

HOME INSTITUTION shall mean the university from which the degree is awarded.

HOST INSTITUTION shall mean the university which has agreed to admit the student for the studying period abroad and which will recognize the studies abroad and which will issue the relevant certification regarding any performed activity, according to the European credits Transfer System (ECTS).

GENERAL PRINCIPLES

The student exchange is founded on a reciprocal basis with the intention of achieving an equal number of units of exchange during a mutually agreed period of time.

There is no obligation on either institution to nominate students for the programme or to accept students.

EXCHANGE RULES

The parties agree to exchange a maximum number of 5 students per academic year. The duration of the exchange will be agreed time by time according to common needs.

The Home institution will be responsible for screening and selecting students.

Students must be fluent in the language of the Host institution country to be admitted to the exchange. If the languages are not very common, the relevant language shall be English.

Exchange students will be subject to the academic rules and discipline of the Host institution.

The Host institution will assist the students when possible but is not obliged to provide housing or financial assistance.

Exchange students shall be responsible for obtaining their own visas and completing the required immigration formalities.

STUDENT ENROLMENT, ATTENDANCE AND ASSESSMENT

Exchange students will be allowed to enrol at the Host institution in any course at any level offered by the School of Engineering of University of Basilicata, Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, School of Civil

Engineering and School of Geology and of School of Applied Sciences, Department of Environment & Natural Resources Engineering of Technological Educational Institute of Crete for which they are qualified, subject to admission requirements, timetables and ability rules of the Host institution. Students will obtain credits for courses in accordance with the regulations of the home institution. The Host institution will issue official transcripts of the credits obtained.

FEES AND SUBSIDIARY EXPENSES

Exchange students will be enrolled in both institutions, but they will pay tuition and other fees only at their Home institution. Unless otherwise agreed, they will pay other personal expenses incurred at the Host institution, including visas, travel, accommodation and meals.

HEALTH INSURANCE

All exchange students will be required to arrange adequate health insurance for the duration of the exchange.

MODIFICATION AND DURATION

This additional protocol may be modified by mutual agreement, in writing, and signed by the two parties. It has the same duration as the above mentioned agreement.
