



**AGREEMENT TO COLLABORATE
between**



**ARISTOTLE UNIVERSITY OF THESSALONIKI (GREECE)
and
CHANGSHU INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY (CHINA)**

In order to establish relations of friendship and cooperation and promote exchanges in education, culture, and scientific research between the two universities, Aristotle University of Thessaloniki (Greece) and Changshu Institute of Technology (China), of their own free will and after friendly consultation, have decided to become friendship universities. On the principle of equality, mutual benefit and respect, the two parties have entered into the following agreement:

Article 1. The two parties agree to collaborate closely on exchange visits, student and teacher interflow, academic exchanges and other fields of mutual interest.

Article 2. For any intended collaborative project, the two parties shall, in accordance with relevant conditions, requirements and targets, conduct separate discussions. Once the two parties have reached consensus, they shall sign a separate agreement on the intended project.

Article 3. No alteration in this agreement shall be valid unless the two parties have discussed, agreed on and signed the alteration.

Article 4. This agreement shall come into force on the date of signature by the presidents/chancellors of the two colleges. If one party wishes to terminate this agreement, it shall notify the other party of its intention in written form six months in advance. Otherwise, this agreement shall extend its validity automatically.

Article 5. The English and Chinese editions of this agreement are equally valid.
