## 2nd AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT IN CONNECTION WITH BILINGUALISM MATTERS

## between:

- (1) The University Court of the University of Edinburgh, a charitable body registered in Scotland under registration number SC005336, incorporated under the Universities (Scotland) Acts and having its main administrative offices at Old College, South Bridge Edinburgh, EH8 9YL ("Edinburgh");
- (2) ARISTOTLE UNIVERSITY OF THESSALONIKI, acting through its school of English, of Thessaloniki, Greece (hereinafter referred to as "AUTH/School of English")

(together the "Parties")

## WHEREAS

- (A) The Parties entered into an Agreement in connection with Bilingualism Matters last signed on 13 February 2014 (the "Agreement").
- (B) The Parties entered into an Amendment to renew the Agreement, last signed on 28 September 2018. (the "First Amendment")
- (C) The Parties agree to make a second amendment to the Agreement as detailed below.

## IT IS AGREED as follows:

- 1. At Clause 5 of the Agreement:
- 1.1 This Agreement will commence on 1st November 2013 and conclude 28th February 2019 or at the end of the AThEME project (whichever is later) or earlier pursuant to clause 5.2." is substituted by the following "This Agreement will commence on 1st March 2019 and conclude on 28th February 2021."
- This amendment shall be without prejudice to any other rights or remedies the Parties may be entitled to under the Agreement and/or at law and shall not affect any accrued rights or liabilities of the Parties.
- The terms of this amendment shall be effective from 1 March 2019.
