



MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

JEONBUK NATIONAL UNIVERSITY, KOREA

AND

ARISTOTLE UNIVERSITY OF THESSALONIKI, GREECE

In furtherance of the Memorandum of Agreement between the two universities, JEONBUK NATIONAL UNIVERSITY (JBNU) and Aristotle University of Thessaloniki (AUTH) agreed to establish a Graduate Fellowship Program according to the terms and conditions in this memorandum agreement.

1. Description of the Program

The goal of this program is to expose JEONBUK NATIONAL UNIVERSITY students to Aristotle University of Thessaloniki and to facilitate cultural perspectives for students participating in the tailor-made program entitled “**Global Proceeding Ex-CRD, JBNU**” a graduate program for the experts of culture and regional develop from 13th to 17th January 2020 to be held at Aristotle University of Thessaloniki campus, Greece. The program schedule is as follows:

At the end of the program, certificates of completion will be issued to participating JBNU students.
(Name of Program must be mentioned in the certificate)

2. Term of Agreement Period

The agreement will be effective for two (2) years from the date of signature, and may be renewable for another two-year term. It will take place until one or both universities mutually recommend its termination or modification. Annual administrative agreements will be signed to capture specific program details, revisions and financial processes.

3. Requirements for Participation

- I. JBNU students who wish to participate in program will be screened for eligibility by Jeonbuk National University.
- II. Students must participate in the approved program for the agreed period.

4. Program Cost

The program fee includes the costs of program coordination, instructors, venues and all the relevant costs. It can be changed upon mutual agreement. An invoice will be issued to JBNU by Aristotle University of Thessaloniki upon confirmation of student participation. Jeonbuk National University will transfer the total amount of program fees to Aristotle University of Thessaloniki. Details of this account will be shared with JBNU to facilitate transfer of funds.

Other expenses, such as accommodation, meals, health insurance, travel fare to other places in Greece and transportation from and to the airport are excluded and it is the participants' own responsibility.

5. Implementation of the Program

- I. Aristotle University of Thessaloniki will be responsible for:
 - a. Providing logistical support in developing and coordinating the tailor-made Program
 - b. Developing content based on JBNU's preference for themes and class topics, and subjects depending on the availability of Aristotle University of Thessaloniki instructors
 - c. Hiring Aristotle University of Thessaloniki instructors to teach academic modules and securing venues for the lectures
 - d. Issuing Aristotle University of Thessaloniki Certificates of Completion for JBNU students upon finishing the course

- Name of program must be mentioned in the certificate.
- e. Coordinating an orientation and End of Program Reception

II. JEONBUK NATIONAL UNIVERSITY will be responsible for:

- a. Selecting JBNU participants (Students and faculty)
- b. Evaluating and establishing participants' English proficiency levels
- c. Ensuring that each participant, including JEONBUK NATIONAL UNIVERSITY instructors, has adequate health insurance
- d. Cooperating for the travel program with Aristotle University of Thessaloniki
- e. The transfer program fee to Aristotle University of Thessaloniki based on the plans

III. JEONBUK NATIONAL UNIVERSITY **students** will be responsible for:

- a. Abiding by the same regulations and performance standards that pertain to other students at the host university
- b. Notifying the JEONBUK NATIONAL UNIVERSITY faculty when traveling outside Thessaloniki, and providing emergency telephone numbers where they can be reached.

6. Coordination of the Program

In order to carry out and fulfill the goals of this agreement, the management of this program is under the responsibility of JEONBUK NATIONAL UNIVERSITY and Aristotle University of Thessaloniki. The program director for this program at JEONBUK NATIONAL UNIVERSITY responsible for coordinating approvals and managing the program is Prof. Lee, Hyeong Woo.

7. Compliance with Rules and Regulations

JEONBUK NATIONAL UNIVERSITY students will be subject to the same rules and regulations as Aristotle University of Thessaloniki students. In addition, they will be expected to comply with the laws and procedures of Aristotle University of Thessaloniki. Aristotle University of Thessaloniki will assume no responsibility for a student's conduct or lack of compliance with any Greek laws. Aristotle University of Thessaloniki reserves the right to dismiss any Program student at any time for academic or personal misconduct in violation of established regulations provided, however that absent extenuating circumstances, attempt is made to consult with JBNU before implementing such action.

8. Modification, Termination, Renewal of Agreement

This Agreement may be modified, revised, or renewed but only upon the mutual consent of the parties in writing. Either party may terminate this Agreement by written notice submitted at least 120 days in advance of the commencement of the next program. Unless renewed by mutual written consent, this agreement will conclude at the end of the specified academic term of year.

9. FORCE – MAJEURE CIRCUMSTANCES

- a. None of the Parties will be held responsible for not fulfilling the obligations of this Contract, when such situation is caused by force-majeure circumstances.
- b. The following events are considered by this Contract as force-majeure circumstances: war, terrorism acts, military operations, revolts, mobilization, strikes at Jeonbuk National University's or AUTH's enterprises, epidemics, fires, explosions, transport accidents and natural disasters, actions of the Government bodies that affect the fulfillment of the obligations, and all other events and circumstances that competent jurisdiction admits and declares as force-majeure circumstances.
