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Article 1er: Les Universités contractantes s'engagent à envoyer l'une à l'autre et à recevoir respectivement
des membres de leurs corps des enseignants, pouvant s'élèver
jusqu'au nombre de quatre en tout par an et pour un délai de
dix à vingt jours pour chacun, afin de tenir des conférences
ou donner des cours sur les matières suivants: mathématiques,
physique, chimie, biologie, droit, langues slaves, philologie classique, histoire. Les conférences ou les cours pourront être donnés dans la langue du pays qui reçoit ou dans l'une des langues
française, anglaise ou allemande; dans ce dernier cas, une traduction dans la langue du pays qui reçoit pourra être organisée soit sur la base d'un texte écrit, qui sera envoyé d'avance, soit au moyen d'un système de traduction simultanée.

Aux fins de l'exécution de l'engagement mutuel cidessus, il sera dressé par un comité de travail mixte, composé
d'un représentant de chacune des deux Universités au plus
tard six mois avant le début de l'année universitaire auquel
il se référera, un plan, valable pour toute l'année, qui comprendra les noms des enseignants qui seront destinés à être
échangés dans le but précité, les domaines scientifiques auxquels se référeront les conférences ou les cours de chacun

SCHOLARS AT RISK N E T W O R K

- In November 2018 AUTH was invited as a partner by SAR and National University Of Ireland Maynooth to submit a program (Marie Curie) H2020-MSCA-RR-2018 entitled INSPIREurope - INITIATIVE TO SUPPORT, PROMOTE, AND INTEGRATE RESEARCHERS @ RISK IN EUROPE with a total budget of € 1.5M (budget for AUTh € 175,000)
- The program was approved and started on 1/9/2019
- AUTH's role is to contribute to the creation of a network for the support of refugee researchers in Southern and Eastern Europe and their integration into the European Research Area.

The Silk-Road Universities Network

- Two AUTH students were awarded at the 2nd WRICOS 2018 Essay Writing and Poetry Competition
- Maria Georgousi, undergraduate student of the Department of English Language and Literature, was honored with the Grand Prize,
- While Angelos Larissis, undergraduate student of the Department of Medicine of AUTh, won the Selection Award.









Alabama - Greece Initiative

- Established in May 2014
- Research Program
- It has led to a series of faculty collaborations between UA and AUTh scholars.
- The two universities undertake the organization of the program successively every year (organized in the University of Alabama in 2014,



2015, 2016, 2018 and 2019 and in Aristotle University in 2014, 2015, 2016 and 2018.)

 The financial support of the program comes mainly from the University of Alabama.

BRAUIC Global Campus Exchange Summer School Program



- Established in 2021
- It is implemented in the frame of the Belt & Road Architectural Universities Consortium, in which the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki is a member since 2017.
- The basic goal of the Program was to build a pool of English-taught summer schools
- AUTh participated with 3 Summer Schools offering free places to students of the member Universities
- Six students from AUTh attended online summer schools free of charge
- The program was implemented completely online, during Covid pandemic



Challenges

COVID - 19 pandemic

- The pandemic created significant problems, but at the same time opportunities
- Some programs stopped temporarily, others resumed remotely
- There were also programs created in the midst of the pandemic and succeeded due to the use of new technologies

Challenges - War in Ukraine

Aristotle University of Thessaloniki decided to implement measures to support its Ukrainian students, as follows:

- 1. Provide **meals** to all affected students (breakfast, lunch and dinner).
- 2. Explore all the possibilities of offering **accommodation** inside and outside university campus for those who face a relevant problem.
- 3. Special **grant** for these students to cover their accommodation and other necessary expenses.
- 4. Contribution to a University **bank account** by the members of the university who wish to deposit a sum of money in favor of the affected students.

Challenges - War in Ukraine

- Collaboration of the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki (AUTh) with Harvard University's Center for Hellenic Studies (CHS)
- Three initiatives are being promoted, as follows:
 - 1. A **donation** from the Center for Hellenic Studies, for AUTh to offer the amount in the form of **scholarships** to Ukrainian students.
 - 2. A joint invitation from the Center for Hellenic Studies and the International Olympic Academy for the participation of 10 Ukrainian undergraduate students of AUTh in their annual Symposium in Olympia (12 to 15 July). The symposium organizers will cover all travel, accommodation, and meal expenses of the students.
 - 3. An invitation of AUTh's Ukrainian postgraduate students, to visit to Nafplio during this fall season and make use of the Center's unique digital library to support their research. The Center will cover all travel, accommodation, and meal expenses of the students.
