# **General Information for UIP 2023**

## 1. Arrival / Departure

- Arrival Date: June 29(Thur) ~ July 2(Sun) 2023
- Departure Date: July 28(Fri) ~ July 30(Sun) 2023
- \* Campus housing will not be offered before the arrival or after departure dates.

Students have to find a place to stay in case of early arrival and late departure.

### 2. Housing

- On-campus dorm
- A room is shared by 2 people and air-conditioned.
- Restroom and shower room are attached to the room.

### 3. Meals

Breakfast will be provided during week days.

Lunch will be provided during a field trip that takes longer than a half day.

### 4. Credits

### 5. Visa (D-2-8)
