**General Memorandum of Understanding
between**

Ryukoku University, Kyoto, Japan

and

Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, Thessaloniki, Greece



Ryukoku University and Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, recognizing the benefits to both institutions (or parties), wish to establish a cooperative relationship through mutual assistance in the areas of education and research, and agree as follows:

Article 1: Educational and Research Collaboration

Each institution may render services to the other for exchanging and procuring educational and research materials and publications available on their respective campuses.

Article 2: Personnel Collaboration

On the exchange of personnel, subject to availability of funds and the approval of each institution's authorized representatives, the host institution shall endeavour to help the visiting scholars, students and administrative staff members by:

- A. Providing assistance with any documents relating to immigration formalities
- B. Introducing other institutions of research and higher education
- C. Providing assistance in securing an accommodation
- D. Providing office space for instructors and researchers on campus
- E. Providing coordinated assistance for research
- F. Providing access to research facilities

Article 3: Development Potential

Ryukoku University and Aristotle University of Thessaloniki may, in the future, continue to discuss the possibility of developing other programs relating to such matters as student exchange, joint research projects, teaching, and administrative staff exchange. As the need arises, both institutions shall prepare separate agreements to implement any specific activities.

Article 4: Renewal, Termination and Amendment

4.1 *Duration.*

This MoU shall remain in force for five years from the date of the last signature. Either party may terminate this MoU by providing 180 days' advance written notice to the other party.

4.2 *Extension and Renewal.*


The agreement will be re-examined by both universities every five years and unless either party wishes to alter the agreement, it will automatically remain in force.

4.3 *Amendment.*

No amendment of the terms of this MoU will be effective unless made in writing and signed by each party's authorized signatory.




