Submit the filled Student Application Form and Learning Agreement by email to the Department of International Relations of AUTh (internatrel@auth.gr). Approval of the signed submitted Learning Agreement by the Institutional Coordinator of AUTh.

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Obtain an appropriate health and medical insurance that covers you for all the period of your stay at the host Institution.
